### Eligibility Criteria:

To participate in the scholarship contest, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be currently enrolled full-time (12 credits undergrad, 10 credits for Graduate/Professional) at any Washington State University campus.
- Have a WSU General Scholarship Application on-file for the 2016-2017 or 2017-2018 Academic Year.
- Submit a essay and photo by 8:00am PST on March 20, 2017 via the online submission form.
- Agree to the Terms & Conditions
- Employees of WSU Student Financial Services (SFS) (student or professional), located at any WSU location, or their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the contest.

By submitting my entry to the #CougsGive Scholarship contest I agree to the following terms and conditions:

- I am not currently employed by WSU Student Financial Services, nor am I an immediate family member (parent, spouse, child, sibling) to anyone who is employed by WSU Student Financial Services, at any WSU location.
- I am a full time student as defined by my program of study for financial aid purposes.
- I have a WSU General Scholarship Application on file for the 2016-2017 or 2017-2018 Academic Year.
- I understand this contest is not affiliated with Facebook.
- I consent to the following:
  - I grant to Student Financial Services (SFS) at Washington State University (WSU) the right and permission to use any written words or stories, whether in original or modified form, photographs, videos, voice recordings or any other likeness SFS has of me/the other featured individual for any purpose and in any and all media.
