What are GET/529 Plans?

GET/529 plans are savings accounts specific to college costs. Once a student is enrolled at WSU, these funds can be applied to the balance on their student account. In order to transfer these funds to WSU, you will need to speak with the GET/529 provider. The funds will be sent to our Bursar's office to be applied.

WSU Charges

Fall charges are posted by the end of **July**.

Spring charges are posted by the first week of **January**.

Summer charges are posted in **April**.

Applying Funds to WSU

Funds are sent to the account holder via direct deposit or check after the original request.

Funds can then be electronically transferred to WSU to help cover the cost of tuition, mandatory fees, housing, etc.
