



Types of Aid for Non-Residents



WUE/Cougar Award

Incoming freshman with 3.0+ unweighted GPA. There are two levels of this award dependent on GPA. WSU Pullman or Vancouver only. Applies specifically to tuition charges. (*Admissions.wsu.edu/scholarships*)

Federal Pell Grant

Federal grant funding that does not need to be paid back. Amount depends on income information on FAFSA.

Federal SEOG

Federal grant funding. Does not need to be paid back. Must meet FAFSA and verification priority deadlines to be eligible.

Student Loans

Must file FAFSA to be eligible. Amounts start at \$5,500 for undergraduate dependents and go up \$1,000 each grade level. Caps at \$7,500 for Jr/Sr. Can be awarded as subsidized or unsubsidized loans dependent on need.

Parent Plus Loan

Financial aid for parents. Must have Third Party Access to complete application. Loan is credit based; Department of Education runs credit check. Repayment starts while student in school.
