Grants

Grants do not need to be repaid. Funds can come from WSU, the State of Washington, or the federal government. Eligibility for grants depends on financial need as determined by your EFC (Expected Family Contribution) which is calculated by completing the FAFSA/WASFA. financialaid.wsu.edu/state-federal-grants/

BORROW

Direct Student Loans

All first year students can receive a maximum of \$5,500 in federal student loans per academic aid year. This limit is comprised of a combination of subsidized and unsubsidized loans. Eligibility for **subsidized** loans is based on financial need. **Unsubsidized** loans are offered regardless of income or assets. financialaid.wsu.edu/student-loans/

Work-Study

Work-study is designed to help qualifying students fund their education through finding employment while attending WSU. Work-study student pay comes from a partnership of federal or state funds, and WSU employer funds. financialaid.wsu.edu/get-a-work-study-job/
